2009 Iron Butt Rally, Day 7 Sunday, August 30, 2009

Jeff Earls remains in first place and Jim Owen remains in second place at the end of Leg 2. In addition to the rest bonus, gas bonus, and two call-in bonuses, Earls scored 30 other bonuses for a total of 45,809 points. Added to his Leg 1 score, Jeff has a total of 62,438 points.

Owen did 2 more bonus locations than Earls and scored 45,386 points for the leg. Combined with his Leg 1 score, his point total stands at 61,667, just 771 points behind Earls.






Moving up from 5th to 3rd place was Eric Jewell. Eric scored 44,875 points on Leg 2, bringing his total score to 59,951. Andy Mills maintained his 4th place position with a Leg 2 score of 38,992 points.

The other riders now in the top ten are Roger Sinclair (who moved from 7^{th} to 5^{th}), Matt Watkins (who moved all of the way from 40^{th} to 6^{th}), Chris Sakala (who moved from 9^{th} to 7^{th}), Ken Meese (who moved from 38^{th} to 8^{th}), Michael Evans (who moved from 16^{th} to 9^{th}), and Bob Lilley (who moved from 22^{nd} to 10^{th} . Riders slipping out of the top ten were Derek Dickson (who slipped from 3^{rd} to 15^{th}), Greg Marbach (who slipped from 6^{th} to 12^{th}), Mike Hutsal (who slipped from 8^{th} to 20^{th}), and Alan Barbic (who failed to bring all of his items to the scoring table and fell from 10^{th} to 74^{th}).





Another significant change in the ranking is Nancy Oswald, now the highest ranking woman, moving from 47^{th} to 16^{th} . Tom and Rosie Sperry, who were the highest ranking 2-up team, slipped from 12^{th} to 54^{th} . Jeff and Milinda Bakker are now the highest ranking 2-up team, moving up from 66^{th} to 30^{th} .

There is little change in the number of riders who are below the target to obtain "finisher" status. 20 riders are below 36,000 points at the end of Leg 2 and, as discussed in more detail below, 7 riders are in the "Did Not Finish" (DNF) category.

A Total of Seven Riders Are Now DNF

In addition to the five riders previously reported to be in the DNF category, two more are out today. Scott LaShier apparently experienced a tire failure somewhere west of Kingman Arizona on Interstate 40, ran onto the median, and then lost control of the bike. He was conscious and able to request that the Rallymaster be called just before he was transported to the closest medical center, but we have not yet been able to obtain any details regarding the extent of his injuries. David Riley is also unable to reach the checkpoint before the close of the window after experiencing tire problems.

The bonus listing for Leg 3 gets distributed at the 4:00 a.m. riders meeting on Monday morning. Tomorrow's report will provide a summary of the options available.
